Our Lady of Grace School is a school in the tradition of the Sisters of the Holy Family of Nazareth that has served the Catholic education needs of families for more than 60 years. Our Lady of Grace School is currently double stream with over 540 students with expected growth to a triple stream school by 2025. A significant building program has just been completed to cater for this future development.

A Strategic Plan for 2020 – 2023 has just been completed after significant consultation that sets out a dynamic and exciting future for the school. Our Lady of Grace's Vision for Learning commits staff to empower all children through Faith, Wisdom and Knowledge to live fulfilling lives in an ever changing world. Our Vision for Learning provides a framework to ensure we focus on;

Provide educational leadership with a Catholic perspective in terms of curricular change and improvement whilst, in collaboration with teaching staff, implementing innovative pedagogy in all areas of learning.

Demonstrate ability to build and maintain strong positive relationships and partnerships with students, parents, staff, Parish Priest of Our Lady of Grace School and Parish and the wider community, by providing leadership that motivates, includes and inspires through highly developed interpersonal skills.
